Pearls in the Pacific. The idyllic islands of Hawaii are often linked to paradise and it's a comparison that is difficult to contradict. These magical isles never fail to enchant every visitor.

The Hawaiian islands are a place of rare beauty and remarkable history. Even their names conjure up mesmerising images. Oahu, the 'Gathering Place'; Maui, the ancient playground of the Hawaiian royalty; Kauai, known as the 'Garden Isle'; the Big Island of Hawaii itself and the 'Pineapple Isle' – Lanai. Each island has its own characteristics and attractions.

Oahu is best known for its world famous beach 'Waikiki', however it has many other hidden secrets for you to explore. There are quieter beaches along the coastline where you can surf or just relax on the beautiful white sand. The north shore is a 'must see' part of the island.

Kauai's highlights include Hawaii's version of the Grand Canyon – Waimea Canyon in the centre of the island. Lush vegetation and spectacular scenery is in abundance as you wind your way to the top of the canyon, from where you can see all the way

to the coast. The Napali coastline of the island is best seen from the air on a spectacular helicopter ride.

Maui has so many breathtaking views for you to enjoy. Experience sunrise at the summit of Mount Haleakala, Maui's highest peak. Drive the road to Hana, passing beautiful waterfalls and inspiring scenery. Lahaina is the original whaling village of the island – today it has great restaurants, bars and shops for you to enjoy.

The 'Big Island' of Hawaii is perhaps the least explored of all. Black volcanic coastlines, lush tropical rainforests and awesome views surround you on this beautiful island. A visit to Volcanoes National Park to see the activity of the erupting Kilauea volcano is an essential part of any visit.

Lanai is the sleepest of the islands with beautiful beaches and enchanting shorelines affording visitors plenty of time to just relax.
