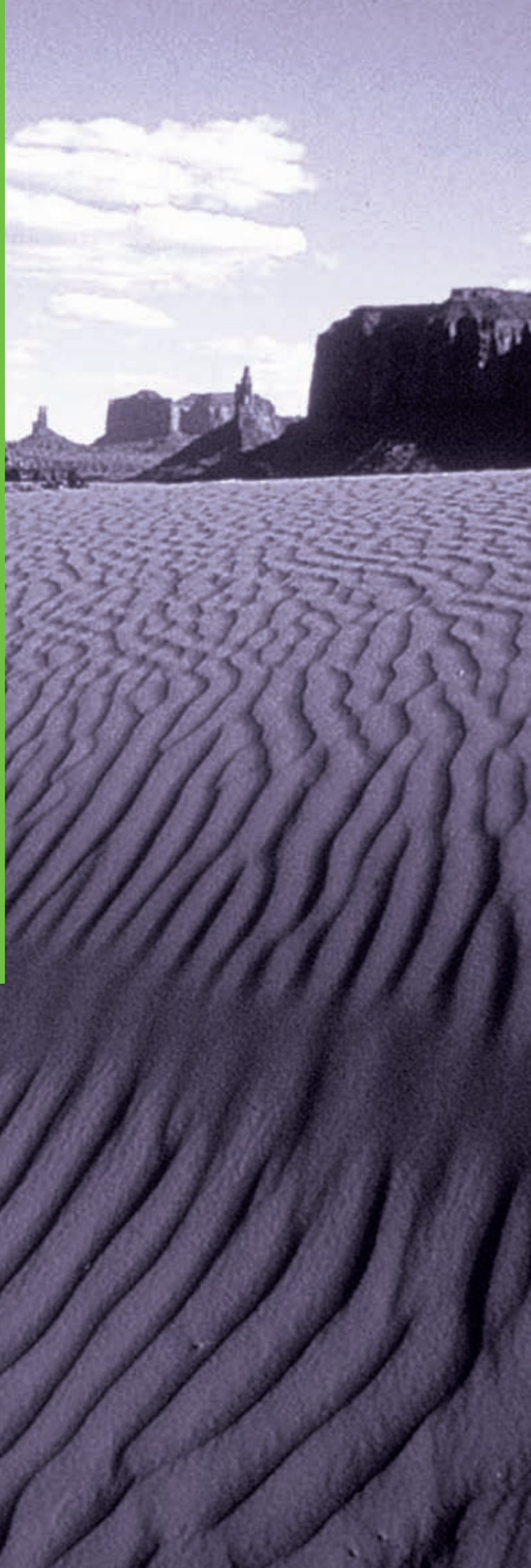

Next is Glacier Bay National Park, where Sitka-spruce forest is alive with grizzly bears and wolves, before visiting Haines, Juneau and Ketchikan. Finally, you'll trail the wonderfully scenic and world-fabled Inside Passage, gliding past a maze of bays and glacier carved fjords, before arrival into Vancouver.
